Dr Peipei Pan's research adopts a multi-disciplinary approach to examine the influence of contextual factors on professional accountants' and auditors' judgments and decision making (JDM). Peipei's research has implications for the globalized business world, various standard setters and regulators, researchers and accounting and auditing professions. Peipei's PhD was awarded the Vice Chancellor's Commendation for Academic Excellence. She has published in the A ranked journals (by Australian Business Deans Council) including *Journal of Business Ethics* and *Accounting*, and *Auditing & Accountability Journal*. The quality and impact of Peipei's research is reflected in her JBE publication, which is presented as "a compelling exemplar" in humanities and language research and provides "timely and timeless insight into the essential culture and values of business" (Virtual Special Issue, p.1 and p. 3).

Peipei has received a number of external grants including the National Science Funding Council of China, and the Sino-Danish Centre for Education Research (SDS), as well as Macquarie University's internal grants including MQ Deputy Vice Chancellor Research Discretionary Fund, MQ Early-Career Researcher Support Scheme Award, MQ Research Infrastructure Scheme (Large) and MQ Outside Studies Program Fund. Peipei is supervising both Master of Research and PhD students at Macquarie and Peipei contributes to global scholarly communities by visiting and providing research and teaching assistance to emerging countries including China (Wuhan University, Nanjing Audit University and South-Central University for Nationalities), and Indonesia (State University of Padang and Andalas University).
